This Release introduces new features, enhancements, and fixes for the vsmStudio software. Please consult the changelog for additional details.

Including

- RNDVSM-40603: Added the ability to share targets via vsmShare.
- RNDVSM-40604: Shared targets can forward their lock state to the consumer.
- RNDVSM-50245: Added "Organizational Folders" to storage groups. These allow for a more productionoriented storage in comparison to the existing locational organization.
- RNDVSM-40707: Various performance improvements to vsmShare.
- RNDVSM-41821: Network Tie-lines would be marked as "duplicates" despite being disconnected.
- RNDVSM-41726: Loading a storage disc containing signals which effected a summing matrix module could cause unexpected results.
- RNDVSM-41108: Added system assisted assignment of parameters, labels and tally when adding a HOME app MV.
- RNDVSM-40497: HOME based signal's network interface assignments are automatically moved when the signal is moved within the [SDN] network.
- RNDVSM-40497: HOME app-based signal's network interface assignments are automatically moved when the app is moved to a different HOME app server.
- RNDVSM-50456: It is now possible to feed a URL from a parameter to e.g. the browser page item via DAS.
- RNDVSM-50511: Possible crash when creating new DMV module.
- RNDVSM-50534: Buttons with an attachment which is deleted will no longer be removed.
- RNDVSM-50535: Panels might switch to the landing page after pushing the config.
- RNDVSM-50439: Switching network signals via tie-lines on a SDN system might trigger unrelated CPC retries.
- RNDVSM-50390: Loosing connection to the HOME node might cause crash.
- RNDVSM-50471: User label with line break character "I" would influence default label behaviour.
- RNDVSM-50475: System colors were cleared when old config closed after new config loaded.
- RNDVSM-50492: Race condition in panel cache after deleting page items.
