

VSM –PATCH RELEASE ANNOUNCEMENT

Version 17.2.1

CONTENT

Major release 17.2 broadens the control of IP infrastructures within the VSM family of products once more. vsmStudio and vsmGadgetServer have been enhanced for the management of IP stream routing in redundant network environments, including but not limited to spine-leaf architectures of Cisco and Arista fabrics. Features integrated into VSM components for the purpose of IP orchestration are merged under *vsmSOUL*, Lawo's seamless orchestration and unification layer.

This Patch Release 17.2.1 includes fixes for vsmStudio, vsmGadgetserver, and replaces vsmTimeSync to the former version.
