

VSM -RELEASE ANNOUNCEMENT

CONTENT

This major release broadens the control of IP infrastructures within the VSM family of products once more. vsmStudio and vsmGadgetServer have been enhanced for the management of IP stream routing in redundant network environments, including but not limited to spine-leaf architectures of Cisco and Arista fabrics. Features integrated into VSM components for the purpose of IP orchestration are merged under *vsmSOUL*, Lawo's seamless orchestration and unification layer.

On top of that, this release contains many other enhancements, improvements and fixes for vsmStudio, vsmGadgetServer and other components.

Release 17.2 refers to vsmStudio built 2202, and all components listed below. For details, please refer to the changelogs and release notes provided with the components.
